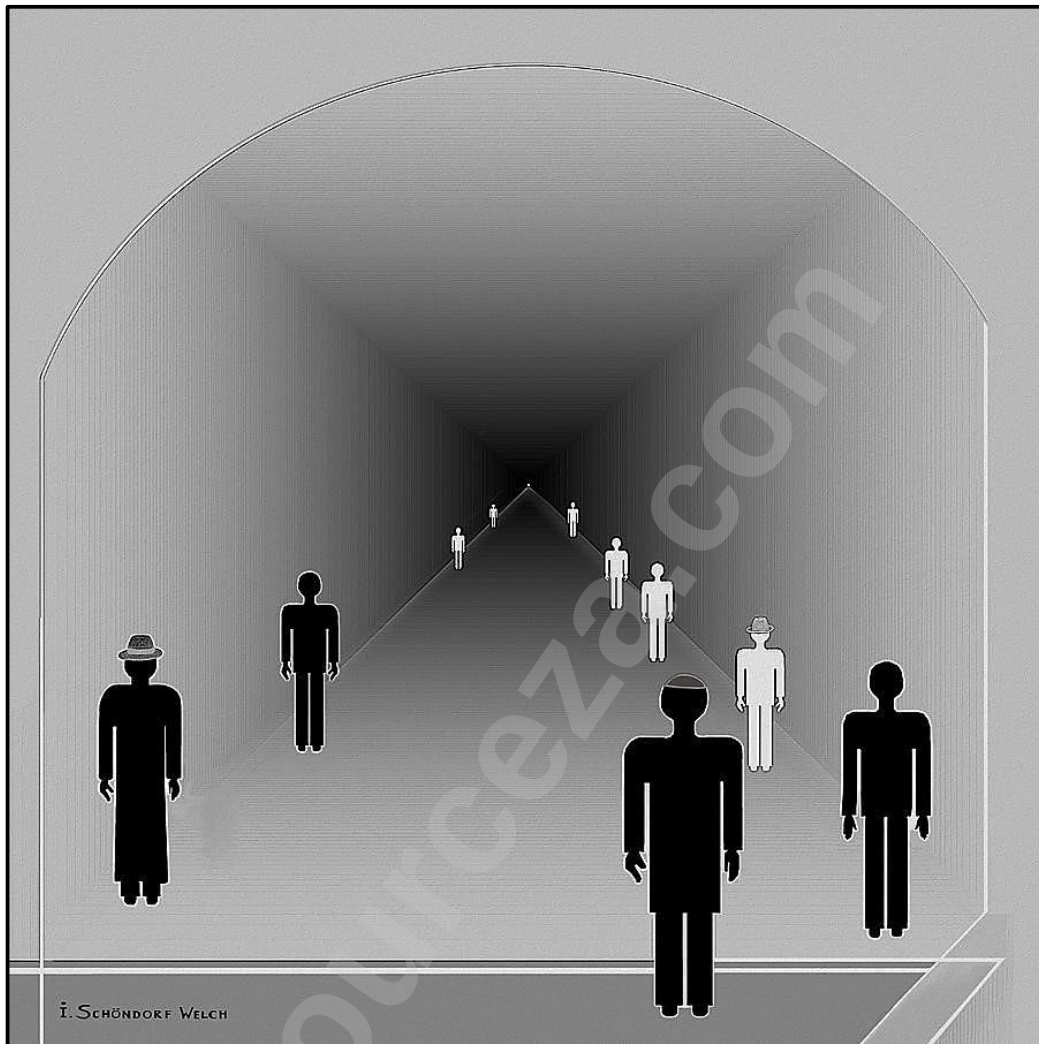

A newly opened coffee shop in a trendy mall is looking for waitrons.

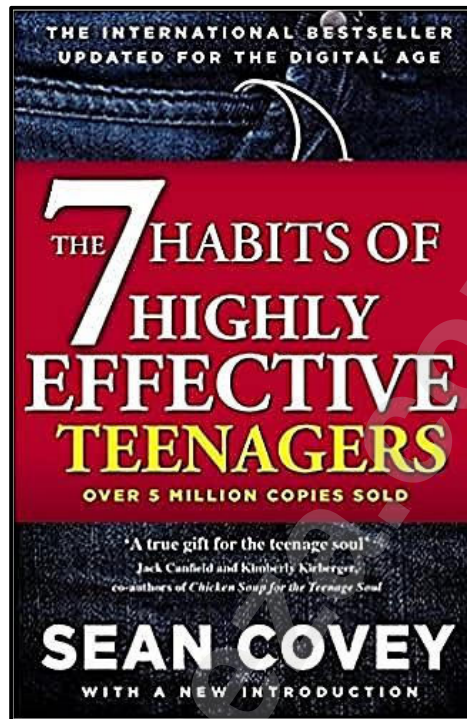
